We are hoping to arrange to spend a year in Europe (perhaps Heidelberg, Germany, where atomic beams work is going on) but that will take six months or more after he is finished. I am working for Prof. Chamberlain's high energy physics group and Prof. Crowe's high energy physics group (about 20 men in all). It is still delightful to work for physicists! At present I am taking evening classes at the University which I am enjoying very much.
