1783 Maria Branwell born Cornwall
1802-1806 Patrick Brontë at Cambridge University
1809 Rev. Patrick Brontë curacy in Yorkshire
1812 Rev P. Brontë Maria Branwell married
1813 Maria Brontë born
1814 Elizabeth Brontë born
1816 Charlotte Brontë born
1817 Patrick Branwell Brontë born
1818 Emily Jane Brontë born
1820 Anne Brontë born
The Brontës remove to Haworth
1821 Mrs. Brontë dies
1822 Miss Branwell comes to Haworth
1824 Maria, Eliza, Charlotte & Emily at Cowan Bridge School
1825 Maria & Eliza die. Charlotte & Emily return home
1826-27 The Plays Jemphrey, Con Felicia & Islanders
origins of Angela - Journal established
1831-1832 Charlotte at School - Roe Head, Hiredfield
1835 Charlotte returns to Roe Head as governess.
Emily spends 3 mos. at Roe Head, when she
returns home Anne takes her place. Bran-
well visits London
1836 Emily's governess at Lawcliffe School, Halifax
for 6 mos.
1839 Charlotte Anne - first situations as governess
in private families
1840 Rev. Wm. Weightman at Haworth. Charlotte &
Emily at Haworth. Anne away as governess.
1841 Charlotte takes second situation as governess
in private home. Anne governess at
Thorp Green.

Brontë Dates Continued.

- 1842 (Feb.) Charlotte & Emily go as pupils to Pensionnat Idées at
Idées, Brussels
- (Oct.) New. W. Weightman dies. Mrs. Branwell dies.
- (Nov.) Charlotte & Emily return to Haworth
- (Dec.) Branwell goes as tutor to Thorp Green
- 1843 (Jan) Charlotte returns to Pensionnat Idées as governess
- 1844 Charlotte returns to Haworth. Rev. R. B. Nicholls
comes to Haworth.
- 1845 Branwell dismissed from Thorp Green.
- 1846 Poems by Currier, Ellis & Taylor Bell published
Charlotte takes Rev. P. Knoute to Manchester for
ocular operation. Begins to write Jane Eyre
- 1847 (Oct) Jane Eyre published
(Dec) Wuthering Heights by Mrs. Grey published
- 1848 (July) Charlotte & Anne visit London
The Tenant of Wildfell Hall published
- (Sept) Branwell dies
- (Dec.) Emily dies
- 1849 (Mar) Anne dies at Scarborough
Shirley published
- 1849-1850 Charlotte visits London & the Lakes. meets Mrs.
Gaskell. Richmond draws her picture.
- 1851 James Taylor goes to India
- 1853 Villette published
- 1854 Charlotte marries R. B. Nicholls
- 1855 Charlotte dies
- 1857 The Professor published (posthumous)
Mrs. Gaskell's life of Charlotte Brontë published
- 1861 Rev. Patrick Knoute dies
