Dear Dale,

I just write to thank you for the most interesting offprint concerning the Sebasteion at Bubon.

I do not know if you have seen the catalog *Glories of the Past: Sculpture from the Shelby White and Leon Levy Collection* (New York, 1990). Item no. 172 (pages 237-38) is the *Weary Herakles* in Boston; no. 174 (pages 240-241) is the *Lucius Vorn* (your Pl. XXVII). Their no. ~~273~~ 173 (pages 238-40), is an over-life-size nude male statue, 221 cms high, which to my eye looks somewhat like your pl. XXIX (*Commodus*) though it now ~~had~~ has a head. From your measurements (p. 224) the torso is 1.40 m x the right leg 0.86 m, which is close but not

identical. I leave this for others better qualified to judge.
