Dear Professor Inan

Thank you for speaking to me yesterday. As I mentioned, I work for Australia's national broadcaster - the Australian Broadcasting Corporation. The *Foreign Correspondent* program on the ABC is planning a trip to Turkey in late August and early September to film a current affairs story about Turkey's efforts to regain her antiquities.

At the moment we hope to focus the story on the battle to reunite the statue of Herakles. We hope to visit the half of the statue in the Antalya Museum, and would also like to visit Perge where I understand you found the bottom half of Herakles. Will you be in Perge in late August/early September? If possible we would be interested in spending half a day or so there, filming you at work.

I would also be very interested to know how many assistants you have at the site, and if you are not there in August/September, who might be there.

I will ask her to contact you over the next week to confirm our interest and to discuss your likely itinerary in August/September.
